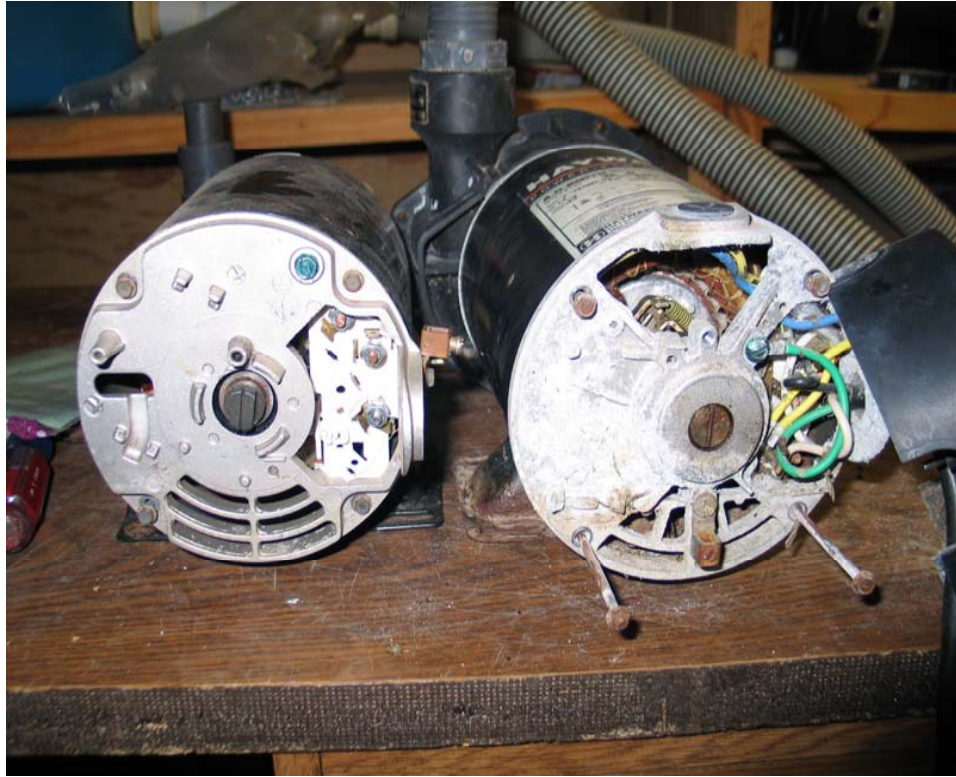

Why go to Pool School?



Pool Opening

1. Hook up pump and filter system and make sure pump works.
2. Fill pool.



- If your motor hums when you plug it in or turn it on. The shaft is locked up. Sometimes you can get it started by turning the impeller shaft of the motor with the pump unplugged. If it won't turn, take it to the motor shop or you need a new one.



- Make sure you lubricate all orings and check for cracks before hooking back up. If there are any cracks or o-rings are dried out, replace them. Replace drain plug on filter and pump if needed. Make sure to take any old thread tape off and put on new.



3. Clean, remove and store winter cover with Stow-Away.

- StowAway®
 - Prepare covers for storage
 - Prevents buildup of mold and mildew
 - Aids in stain and soil removal
 - Eliminates objectionable odors
 - Allows storage of wet cover
 - Store in big trash can for protection against mice.

3. Remove return plug and aquadoor.



4. Vac pool to waste or drain if needed.











6. Brush and clean walls and floor.

Pool Opening

6. Brush walls & floor.
7. Add opening chemicals.
